ENTRIES

1. All entries must be postmarked no later than Friday, July 1st or hand delivered by Tuesday, July 5th to Kristen Low at CJM Stables from 4:30 to 5:00 pm. Make checks payable to **Kauai Paniolo Rodeo Association**. All entry fees **must accompany entry blanks**.
2. Kauai Paniolo Rodeo Association (KPRI) reserves the right to "Team Up" any unmatched partners.
3. Entry fees will not be refunded except for substantial good causes as determined by the KPRI Board. Any such refunds are subject to a \$10.00 penalty per event.
4. All changes must be called into rodeo secretary Linnea Aguiar at 960-1864.

EVENT GUIDELINES

1. Slack events will start at 9 am **SHARP** on Friday. Contestants should check in and pick up numbers beginning at 8 am. Numbers must be picked up prior to Bull Bash. If unable to compete on all days, DO NOT ENTER.
2. Bull Riding, Jr Steer Riding and Keiki Mutton Busting will be 2 go's. First go will be during the Bull bash with second go in the performance Saturday or Sunday depending on position after first go.
3. Top 20 competitors/team will make the Saturday or Sunday performance on the one go and short events. All first go times will be erased and winners will be determined on the short go time. There will be no average. All 1 go events will be in either Saturday or Sunday performance. No slack.
4. Catch pen gate will be open for all roping events.
5. All around saddle will be awarded to the highest point winner. ALL events will be eligible for all around. In the event of a tie, money won will be used to determine the winner.
6. Points will be awarded in each event. 1st to 10th place will receive points. 1st – 10 points, 2nd – 9 points, etc.
7. 30% stock fee on all stock events. \$8.00 can fee on barrels. Events with a short go will be paid 20% to the first go and 80% to short go winners. The number of places will be determined by the number of teams/contestants in the event.
 - a. **Po'o Wai U** – only clean horn catch, one (1) loop. Only legal tie is a non-choke knot. 60 second time limit.
 - b. **All Daily Team Roping** – only two (2) loops. Legal head catches are clean horns, half-head or neck catch. Any front leg is a no time. 60 second time limit. **Century Roping** contestants must be at least 40 years old as of July 22, 2016 and team must equal 100 years. **Mixed Roping** must have one male and one female. **#4 Roping** is capped at a #2. A list is attached of those ropers KPRI numbered as a #2 and below. If you are not listed or have questions about numbers, call Jimmy Miranda at 652-6100.
 - c. **Double Mugging** – one (1) loop. Catch as catch can after rope pass over head. Rope has to be completely free from horse and saddle prior to the roper touching the ground. 60 second time limit.
 - d. **Rescue Race** – The "rescued" rider stands either at or on the barrel at the opposite end of the arena. The rider makes a **left** turn at the first barrel and heads to the second barrel also making a **left** turn picking up "rescued" rider then heads to the finish line. A broken pattern will result in a No Time.
 - e. **Wahine Breakaway** – All contestants MUST come out of the head box.
 - f. **Keiki Barrels** – No leadline allowed. Child must be able to complete pattern on their own. Keiki contestants may share horses. Contestants must be between 5 and 12 years old as of July 22, 2016.
 - g. **Open 2D Barrels** – First go will be Friday night during the Bull Bash. Open to males and females. No sharing horses unless sharing with a child who is only entered in the Keiki Barrels. One entry per person, you may not ride two different horses. Barrel racers have 30 seconds to enter the arena once name is called or a No Time will be given. No circling once in the gate. 3 seconds between D's. Top 20 fast times will return to the show. 1 Buckle for each D, second D buckle determined on the first go. Payouts 1D 60%, 2D 40%.
 - h. **Bull Riding** – Bull Bash Friday night. Contestants must check in at 4:30 pm, gates open at 5 pm, grand entry at 5:30 pm. **\$500 added money for up to 10 contestants, \$1000 for 10 or more contestants.**

GROUND AND CONDUCT RULES

1. Dress code will be long sleeve button-down collared shirt. No tank tops or polo shirts. No tennis shoes or cleats. Cowboy hat or no hat. No baseball caps. Dress code is in effect for slack, bull bash and performances. Koloa Plantation Days 2016 T-shirt can be worn during the slack.
2. All contestants must be ready to compete when called upon. Three calls will be given, then stock will be turned out and a No Time given.
3. Any quarreling or fighting BEFORE, DURING or AFTER the rodeo on the premises involving a contestant with any rodeo official, spectator or other contestant, will result in immediate disqualification from all events, forfeiture of all entry monies and/or monies won, immediate eviction from the premises and suspension from all future rodeos. Any non-contestant will be immediately evicted from the premises.
4. Contestants will be automatically disqualified for injuring or intentionally causing harm to an animal. Any roughing of cattle or schooling or beating a horse in the arena and grounds will result in a No Time.
5. Any decision made by the arena director regarding a contestant's non-compliance will be strictly upheld. Any concerns should be taken up with the arena director. KPRI reserves the right to refuse any entry.
6. This is a drug and smoke free event. Alcoholic beverages may only be consumed in a designated, licensed beer garden.

All contestants must check in with rodeo secretary before first event; all rodeo contestants will receive free admission to the Friday night Bull Bash with back numbers which must be worn on back not on leg.

Waiver and Release

I _____ the undersigned, understand that Hawaii laws chapter 663B, Hawaii revised statutes limits the civil liability of the person sponsoring rodeo activities. I understand that there are inherent risks of injury, including death, when participating in rodeo type activities, which risks include but are not limited to the propensity of an animal to behave in ways that may result in injury or death to persons on or around them, the unpredictability of an animal's reaction to such things as sound, sudden movements, and unfamiliar objects, persons or other animals or objects, hazards such as surface and subsurface conditions, collisions with other animals or objects, and the potential negligence of another participant, such as failing to maintain control over the animal or not acting within the participants ability. Knowing and understanding the risks of participation in a Rodeo activity, including injury and death to my person and damage to my personal property, I expressly choose to assume these risks, I hereby relinquish all claims, demands and causes of action against Kauai Paniolo Rodeo Association, Grove Farm, CJM Country Stables Inc., their heirs, successors, assigns, agents, officers, employees, principles and affiliates from loss or damage to property or injury to myself (and those whom I am a parent or guardian) releasing from y (or my child or ward) being a spectator or competitor while participating in this rodeo.
