- A substantial portion of your handcrafted products must be made in Hawaii & show creativity, originality and uniqueness. <u>Value-added food products will be permitted</u>, <u>however, ready to eat items will not be allowed</u>. Items not listed on your application will not be allowed to be sold at the event.
- 4. Acceptance/approval of your application will be confirmed 2-3 weeks prior to the event. At that time, you will receive your admittance tickets & map showing your booth location.
- 5. We reserve the right to select vendors so that we have a broad representation of products.
- 6. Check in/set-up is from 7:00 AM 9:00 AM only. Breakdown is no earlier than 5:00 PM. Your booth must be staffed at all times.
